

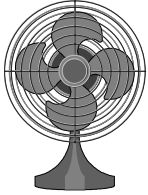

- 1) Find and WEATHERSTRIP AIR LEAKS
- 2) USE THE SUN by opening curtains to help heat a room on a sunny day. Close the curtains when it is hot outside.
- 3) WASH FULL LOADS of clothes in the washing machine and dishes in the dishwasher
- 4) Use ENERGY STAR® qualified appliances
- 5) PLANT A TREE (Trees planted in the right place near a house can save up to 25% of heating and cooling costs)
- 6) TURN IT OFF Turn off appliances (such as computers and televisions) when not in use.
- 7) Change to modern LOW FLOW showerheads.
- 8) Use FLUORESCENT light bulbs. They use 75% less energy.
- 9) TAKE SHORTER SHOWERS to save electricity and water.
- 10) CLOSE THE DOOR to the outside and to the refrigerator
- 11) Always use a programmable THERMOSTAT.
